

The Golden Crown All India Open Snooker Tournament - Season 1

Rules and Regulations

Discipline

All participants are requested to maintain decorum in the club premises.

Any participant, viewers and/or spectators failing to do so will not be permitted to enter the club.

All participants are requested to play in the spirit of the game.

Action will be taken against the participant who disrespects his opponent or the game in any way. The decision of the tournament committee will be final.

The tournament committee reserve the right to add, alter or delete any tournament fixtures, draws, tables, any of the rules without notice and to cancel any of the tournament matches if in their opinion such action is necessary.

By participating the tournament, the player agrees to be bound by the rules, the terms and to all decisions of the tournament committee, which are final, binding and conclusive in all matters.

Walkover

A person coming 10 minutes late will lose one frame.

A person coming 20 minutes late will lose the match.

The Golden Crown Snooker Room clock will be the official and final time keeper.

Dress Code

Qualifying Draw:

A formal attire is encouraged (No Sandals, No Chappals, No Shorts, No flip flops and No torn jeans).

Main Draw:

All participants must wear formal clothing for their matches. Formal trousers and formal shoes, formal shirt/collared t-shirt.

Waist Coat compulsory from semi-finals.

Foul and Miss Rule (Up to Qualifying Stage)

3 (Calls) Foul and Miss Rule will apply.

On the colour balls (yellow onwards), a player needing 4 Snookers or more (40 points or more) will have to COMPULSORILY concede the frame to the player leading at that point.

Main Draw

Foul and Miss Rule as per IBSF will be applicable.

The Final Decision in all matters pertaining to the tournament will lie with the Tournament Committee.
